HIGH SCHOOL IN THE RACE

High schools in the race is a project to make high school students discover motorsport.

The first season took place in 2015.

There are about 7 or 8 races a year, slalom races, which take place all over France, with the biggest in Le Mans.

The single seaters are from the Renault formula with a 1400cm³ Clio engine. or 110 hp, the car can speed up to 200km/h in a straight line.

The covering of the single-seaters was made by Adhesive Lab. This project is a sporting challenge but also a mechanical one because the students maintain the car.

In Vauvert Vocational High School, there are 3 cars: a combustion yellow one, a pink combustion and a white electric single seater. We are the only ones in France!

There are 10 mechanics who are chosen during the winter and two drivers in the team, who are chosen in February during selections at Vauvert.














DIFFERENCE MECHANICS - BODYWORKS



Car mechanics, motorcycle mechanics and bodyworks are really different because the mechanics work inside the vehicle whereas bodyworkers work outside the vehicle. Mechanics fix and maintain the motor, the wheels, the electrical system...The bodyworkers work on the aesthetic outside of the car and fix bumps, holes and structural damage.
